All the chairs are placed on/within the stage area, in the scenic design/scenography, and no chairs are allowed to be placed outside the width of the screen. Distance to row 1 at least 2 m. Distance between seats 0,5 m. The organizer provides black chairs on stage.

Blackout / blackened room: Requirement

Number of audience (in relation to given stage area): around 50. Minimum 15.
